## Overview

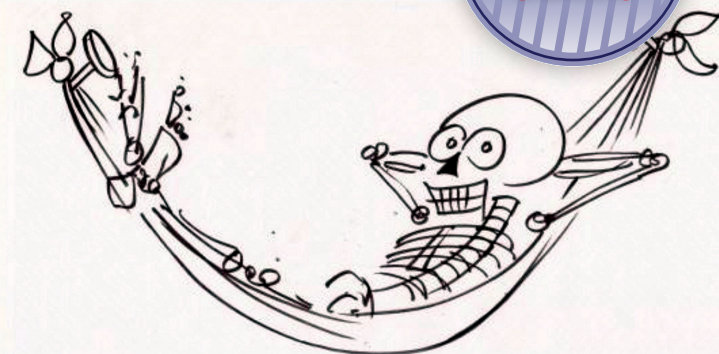

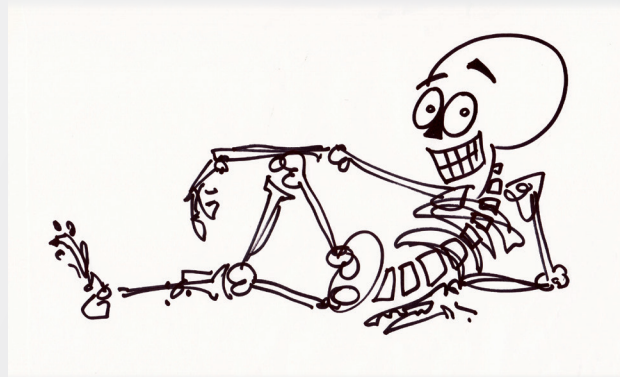
